June 6. Grant to Geoffrey de Welles, king's yeoman, of the custody, during the
Westminster. minority of the heir, of two thirds of the manor of Balitandeny, late of
Miles Talbot, tenant in chief. By K., on the information of H. de Ver.

Safe-conduct, until the Assumption, for William de la More, preceptor of the house of the Temple at Ewelle, Thomas le Engleys, chaplain, Salomon de Whytesand, Nicholas de Semanvill and John de Pontivo, serjeants of the master of the Knights Templars in France, going to various ports and elsewhere in the realm to view wines and other goods taken at sea as they assert by sailors of the realm. St. Nicholas without Carlisle, whereof the king lately recovered the advowson against John, bishop of Carlisle, before the said Hugh and his fellows, justices last in eyre in the county of Cumberland, by judgment of the court; and of the tithes arising from assarts made in the forest of Englewoode without the bounds of any parish, likewise adjudicated to the king by the said judgment.

June 7. Protection with clause *volumus*, for two years, for the countess, late the
Westminster. wife of Roger de Clifford the elder, going beyond seas.

Grant to James de Dalilegh of the prebend of Abreduwly in the collegiate church of Aberwyly, now void by the resignation of Master William Burnell, king's clerk, dean of Wells, and in the king's gift by reason of the voidance of the see of St. Davids. By K.

Pardon to Simon Ban for the death of Thomas Deveroys, as it appears by the record of Elias de Hauvill and his fellows, justices appointed to deliver Norwich gaol, that he killed him in self-defence.
