- June 25. Letters for Isabella de Rupe Forti, staying in Ireland, nominating  
Westminster. Richard de Paynestone and John son of Roger her attorneys in England  
for one year.
- The like for :—
- June 20. Thomas de Piueldesdon, going to Ireland with Gilbert de Clare, earl of  
Westminster. Gloucester and Hertford, nominating Walter de Hendon and  
Thomas son of Thomas de Pyuelesdon for two years.
- June 22. William de Spineto, staying in Ireland, nominating Henry de Spineto  
Westminster. and Henry Gamel for one year.
- June 24. Nicholas, bishop of Kildare (*Daren'*), staying in England, nominating  
Westminster. Laurence de Athy and Geoffrey Bremel, in Ireland until Easter.
- June 28. Walter de Pedwardyn, who is said to have lost the sight of his eyes,  
Westminster. nominating Robert Deverus and John le Gardiner for two years.
- July 1. Geoffrey de Caumvill, going to Ireland, nominating Hugh de West-  
Westminster. monasterio and William de Wotton for two years.  
Reymund de Ferariis, canon of Salisbury, going to Gascony on the king's  
service, nominating ——— de Ackle and John Derling for two  
years.  
Agnes de Valencia, staying in England, nominating Richard le Messager  
and John de Hothum, in Ireland for two years.
- July 8. The prior of St. Andrew's, Northampton, going to his general Cluniac  
Canterbury. chapter, nominating brother Walter de Boudon and William le  
Normaund until St. Andrew the Apostle.  
Henry, prior of Bermundeseye, going to the above chapter and to  
the chapter of La Charité beyond seas, nominating the above Walter  
and William and for the same period.
- July 15. John de Candeure, going beyond seas on the king's service, nominating  
Canterbury. Stephen de Chilton and Roger de Chilton for two years.  
Albert de Flisco, canon of York, staying beyond seas, nominating  
James de Costa Sicca, chaplain, and Martin de Castro Sarzano until  
a year after the Ascension.
- July 15. John de Sancto Johanne, going beyond seas on the king's service,  
Canterbury. nominating Thomas Paynel and Benedict le Taillur for two years.
- The like, for two years, for the following, going beyond seas with the

John de Basynges, knight, nominating William Launceleue and Ralph  
de Basynges.  
William de Gorges, knight, nominating Thomas Paynel and Benedict le  
Taillur.  
Richard de Burhunte, knight, nominating William Launceleue.  
Albertinus Fulbert, nominating Benedict le Taillur and Richard le  
Clerk, of Suwerk.
- July 21. The like for John de Havering, seneschal of Gascony, going to Gascony  
Canterbury. on the king's service, nominating Nicholas de Apperle and Simon de  
Croft until two years after Michaelmas.
- July 24. Henry de Mortuo Mari, going to Ireland with Gilbert de Clare, earl  
Canterbury. of Gloucester and Hertford, nominating John le Seculer for two years.
- July 26. Edmund, the king's brother, going beyond seas, nominating Hugh de  
Canterbury. Vienna and Walter de Reddinges for one year.
