- May 18. Grant to William de Norham, clerk, of the custody of the hospital of
Berwick-on- Capeleford, in the king's gift by reason of the voidance of the see of
Tweed. Durham. By p.s.
- Feb. 9. Pardon, at the request and upon the testimony of Robert son of Payn, to
Geoffrey 'the Hildere' for the death of John de Ambresburia, for which he
is not to blame. By p.s.
- June 1. Grant for life, in enlargement of one during pleasure, to John de Wysham
Berwick-on- of the castle of St. Briavels, and of the custody of the forest of Dene, to
Tweed. hold in the same manner as John de Hanlo had held the same. By p.s.
- March 20. Exemption, for life, for Henry de Malton from being put on assizes, juries,
or recognisances; and from being made sheriff, coroner, or other minister of
the king. By p.s.
- June 15. Writ *de intendendo* directed to the knights and other tenants of Battle
Berwick-on- abbey, upon the restoration of the temporalities to John de Northburne, a
Tweed. monk of that house, elected abbot.
By the earl of Gloucester, keeper of the realm.
- May 20. Henry de Percy, who holds the castle and honor of Alnewyk, is not to be
Berwick-on- disturbed on account of any debts of Anthony, late bishop of Durham, who
Tweed. formerly had seisin of the same. [*Fœdera.*] By p.s.
- May 29. Grant to William de Sulle (or Sulleye) of the custody, free from all pay-
Berwick-on- ments, of the lands of William de Ros of Kirkeby, tenant-in-chief, in en-
Tweed. largement of a former grant to him of that custody during the minority of
the heir, subject to rendering to the Exchequer any issues of the lands in
excess of 44*l.* a year, and of the marriage of the heir. By p.s.
- June 1. Licence to Alexander de Bykenore, king's clerk, to crenellate his dwell-
Berwick-on- ing house of Ruardyn, co. Gloucester. By p.s.
Tweed.
- June 1. Pardon, at the instance of Alexander de Bykenore, king's clerk, treasurer
of Ireland, and for good service in Scotland, to Roger de Wythiford for
the death of William son of Peter de Egemundon. By p.s.
- May 30. Grant, in fee, to Fortener de Lescu, for his homage and service, of the
Berwick on- land called 'Tuseblanke,' in the bishopric of Ayre, formerly acquired by the
Tweed. late king from Emericus de Reuynan, burgess of Perker, subject to such
services as were formerly due from that land, also to suit of the king's court
of St. Sever in the assize of the seneschal of Gascony, and to the render of
a lance with a iron-gilt head by name of relief (*nomine sporle*) for all ser-
vices, customs and demands.
Mandate to the seneschal of Gascony, the constable of Bordeaux, the
provost of St. Sever, the king's bailiff of Sengyn (*ballivo Regis Bastide
de Sengyn*), and to all other provosts, bailiffs and ministers of the king for
the duchy [of Aquitaine], to allow him to hold the land.
Mandate in pursuance to the seneschal and constable, or their deputies, to

- June 1. Exemption, for life, at the instance of Henry de Percy, for Nicholas de
