Sept. 7. Licence to Robert Baynard to crenellate his dwelling-place of Great Westminster. Hautboys, co. Norfolk. By K., on the information of H. le Despenser.
- Sept. 5. Presentation of Master Stephen le Bygod to the church of Brokedisshe, Westminster. in the diocese of Norwich. By K.
- Presentation of Arnald Lupi de Tillio to the church of Hethille, in the diocese of Norwich. By K.
- Sept. 7. Grant in part payment of 560 marks, in which the king is bound to Westminster. Thomas Wale for a release to him and to his heirs of the wood in the county of Northampton, which is between the trench called 'la Bernette' and the forest of Whitlewode and extends towards Wappenham and le Frethe of Bukenhulle, of the custody of the manor of Retheresfeld, co. Oxford, in the king's hands by reason of his custody of the heir of John de Grey, tenant in chief, which is extended at 19*l.* 2*s.* 2*d.* a year, to hold for 10 years with all matters appertaining to that custody to the value of 150*l.* If the heir shall attain full age before the completion of the term of 10 years, Thomas Wale is to receive compensation out of other custodies of any part of the sum of 150*l.* remaining unpaid. - Sept. 9. Pardon to Geoffrey Luterel, as a set off against an equal sum out of the Westminster. wages due to him from the king, of 31*l.* in which he is bound to the king, viz. in 25*l.* of the scutage of Wales for the year 10 Edward I. from the time of Robert Luterel his father, in 100*s.* for many defaults, and in 20*s.* for an amerciament, which sum of 31*l.* is required of him by summons of the Exchequer. - Aug. 31. Safe-conduct, until Easter, for Blaise Aldebrandini, king's *yeoman*, sent Westminster. beyond seas to buy horses and to purvey other necessaries for the king. By K., on the information of E. de Malo Lacu.
- Sept. 8. Protection in Ireland, for two years, for John archbishop of Dublin Westminster. staying in England on the king's service. By K., and pet. of C.
- Sept. 8. Licence, during pleasure, to Hugh le Despenser the younger to hunt with Westminster. his dogs by himself, or by any person whom by his letters he shall depute to do so, fence month excepted, foxes, hares, cats and badgers, but he may not take or cause to be taken any of the king's great deer. By K., on the information of E. de Malo Lacu.
- Sept. 10. Presentation of Laurence de Rustiton to the church of Theberton in the Westminster. diocese of Norwich. By K., on the information of Hugh le Despenser.
- Sept. 11. Letters of licence to elect for the sub-prioress and convent of Chester, Westminster. although they have not notified to the king the voidance of their house by reason of the death of A. late prioress of that place.
- Sept. 11. Appointment, until All Saint's Day, of Robert de Donecastre, to buy Westminster. oats, hay, litter and beans for the king's palfries. By K.
- Sept. 10. Protection, for one year, for Edmund de Malo Lacu. Westminster.
- Sept. 8. Pardon to Germain le Engleys, batillier, for the withdrawal of Guiller- Westminster. minus, nephew of Peter de Parco Fyaco, and the removal of goods belonging to the said Peter, for which he was tried in the island of Gerneseye. Pardon also for abjuring Gerneseye and the other [Channel] islands. By K., on the information of E. de Malo Lacu.
- Sept. 15. Mandate to the justiciary of Ireland to restore the temporalities of the Westminster. archbishopric of Armagh to Roland, a Friar Preacher, preferred by
