June 24. Presentation of Thomas de Sibbethorpe, clerk, to the church of Shenle,
Woodstock. in the diocese of Lincoln. By p.s.
- June 3. Grant of 500 marks, to be received out of the issues of the custom on wool,
Westminster. hides, and wool fells in the port of London, to Roger Ardingelli, Dinus
Forcetti and Francis Balduch', and their fellows, merchants of the
society of the Bardi of Florence, who by the king's command paid to
Aymer de Valencia, earl of Pembroke, 500 marks in part satisfaction of a
sum in which the king was bound to him. By p.s.

- June 12. Safe-conduct until St. Peter ad Vincula for Thomas, earl of Lancaster,
Westminster. and his followers, coming to the king on the feast of SS. Peter and Paul
the Apostles. By K.
- June 9. *Inspecimus* and confirmation of a grant by John de Moubray, lord of the
Westminster. Island of Haxiholm, to John de la Ryvere of Brandesby and Matilda his
wife, and the heirs of their bodies, of a messuage and $3\frac{1}{2}$ bovates of land
in Eppeworth, subject to the render of a barbed arrow at Michaelmas
every year; with reversion failing such issue to the said John
de Moubray and his heirs; witnesses, John de Creppinges, knight, William
Moigne, Thomas de Beltoft, Ralph de Brunnun, William Crake, Walter de
Brunnun and Geoffrey de Ros; dated at Eppeworth in the feast of SS.
Philip and James the Apostles, 11 Edward II. By p.s.
- June 16. Commission to A. bishop of Hereford, John Abel, knight, and Master
Westminster. Richard de Burton, clerk, to take on the king's behalf the oath of fealty to
Philip, king of France, for the duchy of Aquitaine, and for all lands which
the king holds beyond the seas.
- June 12. Protection until St. Peter ad Vincula, with clause *volumus*, for A. bishop
Westminster. of Hereford going beyond the seas by the king's command. By K.
- June 12. Pardon of their outlawry in the county of York to John de Bretteville,
Westminster. Geoffrey Lewyn, Sampson Paytevyne, Hugh Haukyn, Peter Haukyn,
Henry Haukyn, Thomas de Snape, Roger le Norreys le porter, Walter
Doun, Robert de Shylington, Elias de Kelsouth, Hugh de Hecham, John
Puy, John de la Sale, William de Blith, John Wodeman, Walter de
Alnemouth, William Paytevyne, Thomas Lescote, Patrick le Taillur,
Thomas Thorald, John le Taynturer, John de la Gore, Richard de Dalton,
William de Aketon, Richard de Aketon, Robert de Musgrave, Robert de

- May 25. Grant of the king's gift to Edward, earl of Chester, the king's son, in
Westminster. aid of his maintenance, beyond the lands and tenements already granted to
him, of 1000 marks out of the issues of tin in the county of Cornwall.

- Mandate in pursuance to Henry de Wylngton, the king's steward of
Cornwall.
