- March 14. Derby. Mandate to Richard Wroth, keeper of the land of Gower, to pay out of the issues of Gower to Master John Walewayn, appointed viewer and superior keeper of divers castles and lands in Wales, which are in the king's hands, for himself and the men at arms who by the king's ordinance are in his company to wit, from the date of his commission until Friday last, 12 March, 20s. a day, and from the said 12 March for as long as he is in the said office, a mark. By K. on the information of Master Robert de Baldok.
- March 13. Derby. Licence for Robert de Leyburn to crenellate his dwelling-place of Aykhurst, co. Cumberland. By p.s.
- Writ of aid for John Haclut, king's yeoman, appointed to arrest Nicholas de Guldeford, clerk, and William Trussel, wherever they may be. By K.
- The like for John de Faucunberge to arrest John de Evre.

- March 13. Derby. Appointment during pleasure of William Gentilcors, king's yeoman, to to the bailiwick of the forestership of the chaces and parks of Tuttebury, at the usual wages. By K.
- March 13. Derby. Master Walter de Islep, parson of the church of Whityndon, going to Ireland on the king's service, has letters nominating Roger de Sutton his attorney for four years.
- March 15. Derby. Grant during pleasure to Res ap Griffith, king's yeoman, in consideration of his past and future service, of the castle and manor del Herber in West Wales, which is in the king's hands, to hold quit of any rent for the same. [*Parl. Writs.*] By K.
- March 16. Warsop. Writ of aid for John de Haustede appointed to arrest Peter de Denardeston in the counties of Norfolk and Suffolk, and to take into the king's hands his lands. [*Parl. Writs.*] By K.
