March 2. Ratification of the estate of Laurence Turney, king's clerk, in the church

Westminster. from Simon Freman, of Skendelby, a messuage and land in Skendelby held in chief, and entering thereon without licence; and restitution to him of the same. By fine of  $\frac{1}{2}$  mark.

March 7. Safe-conduct until Michaelmas for W. bishop of Norwich, going beyond  
Westminster. seas on the king's service. By K. & C.
