Westminster. of Essex for non-appearance before the justices of the Bench to answer  
the abbot of Waltham Holy Cross touching a plea of debt of 12l. ;  
he having now surrendered to the Flete prison, as Robert de Thorpe,  
chief justice, has certified,

Jan. 20. Exemption for life of John de Warbelton from being put on assizes,  
Westminster. juries or recognitions, and from appointment as mayor, sheriff,  
escheator, coroner, or other minister or bailiff of the king against his  
will. By p.s.

Jan. 20. Pardon to Adam Fisser of Assho of the king's suit for the death  
Westminster. of Richard Tailour of Assho ; as the king has learned by the record  
of Thomas de Ingelby and his fellows, justices appointed to deliver  
the gaol of Warwick castle, that he killed him in self defence.

Jan. 20. Philip de Popham, 'chivaler,' staying in England, has letters  
Westminster. nominating Nicholas Castel Martyn, 'chivaler,' and Nicholas  
Wythyngton as his attorneys in Ireland, and to sue and defend his  
liberties there ; for one year. W. Power received the attorneys.

Jan. 24. Pardon to the dean and chapter of the church of St. Paul, London,  
Windsor. for entering without the king's licence into tenements and  
rents in London, held of the king in burgage as all the city is, granted  
and bequeathed to them by the persons named below, some for chantries  
and obits in the said church and 'le cruddes' therein, some for the  
sustenance of poor clerks called 'queristres,' and some in aid of the  
fabric and works of the church and for other pious uses by the following :

in Stanynglane,
- by Gilbert de la Bruere, tenements and rents and a quay in the  
parish of St. Benet by Pouleswherff,
- by John de Beauchamp, tenements and rents in the parish of  
St. Mary Aldermanbury, with the advowson of the church  
of St. Michael Bassyngeshawe,
- by Robert de Keteryngham, tenements and rents in the parish  
of St. Mary Magdalene, Oldefisshstrete,
