March 25. Association [pursuant to 1 Edward III., statute 1, cap. 3] of W., bishop  
Westminster. of Norwich, John de Warena, earl of Surrey, and Henry de Bello Monte,  
baron, with Geoffrey le Scrope and the other justices of the King's Bench  
to hear the complaint of John Scut of Carleton that he made a recognisance  
in 32*l.* 10*s.* by force and duress, after the exile of the Despensers, and to  
annul the same.

March 28. Commission of oyer and terminer to Ralph Basset of Drayton, William
