- Aug. 12. Licence for John de Coloygne, king's yeoman, to crenellate his houses on  
Tower of Cornhill, London. By p.s.
- Aug. 29. Writ of aid, for one year, for John de Eston, king's clerk, receiver of  
Westminster. queen Philippa, charged by her to carry money and things belonging to her  
from the parts of York to London. By K.
- Aug. 30. Grant to Thomas de Ferariis and Theobald de Mounteny, king's yeoman,  
Westminster. of the forfeiture due by Isabella de Moëles, one of the daughters and heirs  
of John de Moeles, tenant in chief, the king's ward, by reason of her having  
married William de Boterels, knight, without licence. By p.s.
- Sept. 1. Grant to Henry, bishop of Lincoln, that, whereas the king by letters  
Westminster. patent lately granted to him the custody, during minority of the heir, of two  
parts of the lands late of John de Mohun of Dunster, tenant in chief, and  
afterwards these two parts were taken back and committed to others, and  
whereas he by other letters patent granted to him the custody of the lands  
of the said inheritance which the lady of Mohun, late the wife of the said  
John, held in dower, which were said to have come into his hands by her  
death, and she is still among the living, the latter grant shall remain in force,  
so that, if the said lady die before the heir attain his full age, he shall have  
the custody of her said lands, during minority of such heir, according to the  
tenor of the king's grant. By K.

- Oct. 21. Presentation of John de Weston to the church of Chirchelalleford, in the
