Appointment, during pleasure, of Engerard de Cygony to the custody of the forest of Windesore; with writ *de intendendo* to the foresters and verderers thereof.

May 13.

The king sends Henry de Aldithelegh to the parts of Chester to keep the peace of those parts, and commands the barons, knights, constables and all good men holding of the earl of Chester in the county of Chester, according to the inborn fealty which they have always had towards their lords, to be manfully assisting to him herein.

The like mandate to the same with regard to A. bishop of Coventry, whom the king sends with the said Henry.

May 15.

Royal assent to the election of Isabel de Nevill, nun of Rumeseye, to be abbess of that place, with writ *de intendendo* in her favour to the tenants of the abbey.

Grant to William de Mastac of the manors of Wycham, co. Suffolk, and Schorestan, co. Wilts, during the minority of the heir of Richard de Harecurt, a Norman; on this condition, that the king will assign to him and his heirs within the said term 50*l.* a year of land, and then the said manors shall revert to the king.

Appointment of Richard de Levinton, Lambert de Muleton, Thomas son of John and Ralph de Feritate as justices to deliver Carlisle gaol on the morrow of the octaves of Trinity.

[Cancelled.] *Because on the back of this roll.*

Grant to Hugh de Pateshull, the treasurer, for a fine of 300 marks, of the custody during the minority of the heirs of the lands late of Ralph Paynel: with the custody and marriage of the heirs, as more fully contained in the Fine Roll.

Protection, until Michaelmas, for William de Mastac.

Exemption, for life, of William de Legh from suits of counties and hundreds, and from being put on assizes, juries or recognitions.

For brother John the Almoner.

Presentation to the bishop of Salisbury of Martin de Sancta Cruce to the church of Gerardeston, in the king's gift by reason of the voidance of the abbey of Wilton.

Presentation to the official of the lord of Canterbury in the diocese of Norwich of Peter de Mungumery to the church of Beyghton, in the king's gift by reason of the voidance of the bishopric of Norwich.

The like; directed to the official of the archdeacon of Norwich.

May 20.

Royal assent to the election of Alice, prioress of Wilton, to be abbess of that place; and mandate to R. bishop of Salisbury, to do his part herein.

Grant to W. bishop of Carlisle, who has the custody of the lands and heirs of John de Jarpunvill, that he and the men holding of that custody, shall be quit during the minority of the heirs, of the suits which are due to the king at the court of Hageneth from the bishop by reason of the custody and from the said men.

Protection, for four years from Whitsunday, for Thomas de Lascelles.
