Presentation of Gaylard Durnod to the church of Haninton, in the king's gift by reason of the voidance of the bishopric of Winchester; directed to Master A. official of the archdeacon of Winchester.

Appointment, during pleasure, of Bernard de Sabaudia to the custody of the castle of Windlesor; and grant to him for this custody of the service of the knights' fees which are held of the castellany, with the new purpresture brought into cultivation and 10*l.* a year, and one tun of wine a year of the king's gift, so long as he keep the said castle.

Grant to Robert de Cantuaria of the custody, during the minority of the heir, of the land late of John son of Robert de Cantuaria in Sapindon, in the king's gift by reason of the voidance of the archbishopric of Canterbury, of which archbishopric the said John held in 'gavelicund.'

Mandate to the guardians of the archbishopric to give him seisin thereof.

Appointment, during pleasure, of Bernard de Sabaudia to the custody of the castle of Windlesor with the forest; and grant to him for this custody of the yearly castle-guards of knights which are held of the castellany, with the king's new purpresture brought into cultivation and 10*l.* a year by the hands of the bailiffs of Windlesor, and one tun of wine a year, of the king's gift, so long as he keep the said castle.

Appointment of John de Plessetis to the custody of two parts of the lands late of John Byset and of Ela and Isabel, two of his daughters and heirs, saving to Alice late his wife her dower therein, to hold to him or his assign during the minority of the said Ela and Isabel, with their marriage.

Jan. 7.

Mandate to H. de Aldithele to deliver the castle of Muthaut, which he fortified by order of the king, to J. Lestrange, justice of Chester, or the bearer of his letters patent.

Mandate to the said John to receive it and keep it safely until further order.

Jan. 8.
Westminster.

Prohibition of a tournament about to be held at Brackele on the day or morrow of St. Hilary.

Mandate to the abbot of Oseneye and the prior of St. Fredeswyde's, [Oxford,] to be there on those days to prohibit it.

Protection without term for the brethren of the hospital of St. Bernard, Montjoux.

Jan. 9.
Westminster.

Grant to Fulk de Castro Novo of the manor of Gatton, for his maintenance in the king's service, until the king surrender it to the right heirs.

Jan. 10.
Westminster.

The like to the same of 80 marks a year out of the issues of the town of Staunford, during the minority of John de Warena, son and heir of W. earl of Warenne, for his maintenance as above; with mandate to the bailiffs to pay it to him.

Jan. 11.
Westminster.

Presentation of Martin le Littlebury to a mediety of the church of Blakeburn, in the king's gift by reason of his custody of the land and heir of J. earl of Lincoln; directed to the archdeacon of Chester.
