1253. Exemption for life of Robert de Stutevill from being put on assizes, juries or recognitions. By K.
Simple protection without term for him. By K.
- Feb. 20. Royal assent to the postulation of Thomas Occuyn, of the order of Windsor. Friars Minors, to be bishop of Clonmacnois (*Clomen'*), with mandate to the justiciary of Ireland to do his part herein on behalf of the king.
Quit claim to Nicholas le Messenger of all right which the king had in that messuage in Stanford sometime of Cok, Jew of Stanford, which is said to be the king's escheat. And when the king has deraigned the said messuage in his court, he will grant it by charter to the said Nicholas and his heirs. By J. Maunsell.
- Feb. 22. Letters for the abbot of Fécamp, nominating Martin de Rupe, monk Windsor. and his bailiff in England, as his attorney. By K.
Grant to the prior and convent of St. Augustin's, Canterbury, for a fine which they have made for the keeping of the abbey during voidance this time, of the tallage which the king caused to be assessed throughout the manors of the abbey at the time of the present voidance, with all other issues and profits received therefrom at the said time. By K.
Signification to the pope of the royal assent to the election of Roger de Cycestre to be abbot of the said abbey, which is immediately subject to the church of Rome, requesting him to proceed to confirmation. By K.
Exemption for life of Andrew de la Brache, serjeant of the king's sister, Eleanor, countess of Leicester, from assizes, juries or recognitions and from all suits belonging to the king's courts. By K.
Grant to the abbot of Creystayn that by reason of a general summons before the justices in eyre for common pleas or for pleas of the forest he shall not be amerced or charged for four years from St. Peter's in Cathedra, 37 Henry III. By K.
- Feb. 23. Exemption for life of Roger Parlebien from being put on assizes, juries Windsor. or recognitions. By K.
Royal assent to the postulation of Christinus, of the order of Preachers, to be bishop of Ardfert, and mandate to the justiciary of Ireland to give the royal assent accordingly. By K.
- Feb. 25. Exemption for life of John de Rocheford from being put on assizes, Windsor. juries or recognitions. By K.
Grant to Richard de Tillebiry of the wardship of the land and heir of Laurence de Plumberge with the marriage of the heirs (*sic*), if the wardship belongs to the king by reason of the said heirs.
Mandate to the escheator in the county of Essex to give him seisin of the said land and heirs. By K.
Grant to Robert de Oye and John his brother of the year, day and waste belonging to the king of the lands, woods houses and other tenements late of William de Langedon, with the chattels of the said William, who fled for the death of the shepherd of the abbot of Langedon. By H. de Wingham.
Mandate to the sheriff of Kent to let them have the same.
- Feb. 28. Grant for life to Nicholas le Chaundeler, king's serjeant, of 1½*d.* a day Westminster. which Robert le Blund, sometime king's messenger, used to receive in his lifetime out of the issues of the county of Gloucester.
Mandate to the barons of the Exchequer to cause this to be done and enrolled.
