To the barons and good men of Winchelse, Hethe and la Rye. Because Henry Pethun, the king's enemy and other his accomplices hold out in the isles of Wight and Porlaund and elsewhere along the sea coast, in order to aggrieve the king and his faithful, the king commands them with all their strength and diligence to pursue, take and keep them, and to keep and defend the sea coast of those parts, as queen Eleanor and Roger de Leyburn will let them know on the king's behalf; and for their expenses herein, the king, with the assent of the merchants on this and beyond the sea bringing merchandise to and from the realm, grants that upon every ship laden with merchandise entering or leaving the realm, they shall take 40s. and from every empty ship 20s., until the feast of St. Peter's Chains; and if they expend more, the king will cause them to be so paid after the said term so that they shall be content.
