Nottingham. The like of the king's brother Thomas Beaufort, 'chivaler,' to keep the castle, town and lordship of Lodelowe from 21 August next during pleasure. By K.

Tideswell. Order to the sheriff of Stafford to compel all the fencible men of the county to go arrayed when required with the king's kinsman Thomas, earl of Arundel, the king's lieutenant on the frontiers of the parts of North Wales from the castle of Holt to Wygemere. By K.

Manor. Order to the sheriff of Lincoln, because the king is informed that the duke of Albany and the earl of Douglas with a great multitude of Scots intend to enter the realm by the Assumption of St. Mary or soon after, to cause a proclamation to be made that all the knights, esquires and yeomen of the county are to go to the marches of Scotland when required by the wardens of the same to resist the king's said enemies, notwithstanding the previous proclamation ordering them to Wales; but if the said enemies do not come they are to go to the king at Shrewsbury by 1 September next.
