Oct. 15. Presentation of John Baker to the church of Quarele, in the diocese  
Westminster. of Winchester.

Oct. 16. Grant for life to John Hill of the office of armourer for the king's  
Westminster. body within the Tower of London with the due wages, fees, profits  
and other commodities as Stephen Fryth, John Downton and others  
have had.

Oct. 20. Robert Typtoft, going by the king's licence beyond the seas, has  
Westminster. letters nominating John Typtoft, 'chivaler,' and John Bedulf his  
attorneys in England for one year.

The chancellor received the attorneys until the return of  
the nominator to England.

Oct. 2. Grant to the king's kinsman Richard, lord of Grey, the king's  
Westminster. chamberlain, of the keeping of the manor of Retherfeld with the chace  
there and of all other lordships, lands, rents, services, franchises,  
liberties and other possessions and profits pertaining to the same  
lordship and chace, which keeping is worth 64*l.* yearly, to hold to that  
value so long as the premises are in the king's hands on account of the  
forfeiture of Thomas, late lord le Despenser, or by reason of the  
minority of his heir, and so from heir to heir, provided that if the  
premises exceed that value he shall answer for the surplus at the  
Exchequer and that he shall maintain the houses, woods, enclosures  
and gardens without waste and support all charges.

being in his hands on account of the war with France, on an exchange  
of benefices with William Joye.

Oct. 22. Protection with clause *volumus*, for one year, for Nicholas Talbot,  
Westminster. staying on the king's service in the company of the king's son Thomas  
de Lancastre, steward of England, lieutenant of Ireland, on the safe-  
custody of that land.
