Feb. 13. Commission to Simon Blakborn, serjeant at arms, and the sheriffs
Westminster. of Cambridge, Essex, Norfolk and Suffolk to enquire about the carrying
of wheat, barley, malt, beans, peas, oats or other kinds of corn to
foreign parts besides the town of Calais, contrary to the king's
ordinance and proclamation.

Vacated because nothing was done.

Feb. 25. Commission to Edmund Oldhalle, William Snetesham and Simon
Westminster. Baret to enquire into the report that divers lands, rents, possessions,
fruits and profits of the church of Dokkyng, co. Norfolk, which is
parcel of the alien priory of Munstrelovell, in the king's hands on
account of the war with France, are withdrawn, alienated, wasted
and detained by the late farmers and other lieges of the king.

day he died and who is his heir.
