June 10. Whereas John Colvyle, 'chivaler,' John Inglithorpe, 'chivaler,'
Westminster. Laurence Everard, 'chivaler,' Henry Rochefort, 'chivaler,' John
Candeler, clerk, Laurence Trusbut, Thomas Lovell, John Yelverton,
Walter Godard, John Shuldham, Thomas Hall and Nicholas Lomenour
were seised of two messuages in the town of Bishop's Lenn adjoining
the manse of the prior and convent of the friars of the order of hermits
of St. Augustine in the same town, of the value of 40*s.* yearly, late
of Alice Pulter, to the use of the said prior and convent, who took
the profits ; and afterwards, because by an inquisition taken before
William Rokewode, late escheator in the county of Norfolk, it was
found that the said prior and convent by the name of the prior of the
priory of the friars of St. Augustine, Bishop's Lenn, appropriated the
messuages to themselves by the hands of John Straunge, 'chivaler,'
Walter Godard, Edmund Eldehall, Simon Baret and others without
licence of the late king, though the said John Straunge, Edmund and
Simon never had anything in the messuages, the escheator by virtue
of the statute of 15 Richard II seized the messuages into the hands
of the said late king as forfeited and they are still in the king's hand ;
the king grants them to the prior and convent in mortmain for the en-
largement of their manse, to keep the anniversaries in their church
of the king's father Henry, late king of England, and the king's
mother Mary, his late consort, and of the king after his death.
