Aug. 8. Licence, for 25 marks paid to the king by the abbot and convent of Oxford. Coverham, for the alienation in mortmain to them by John Fairfax, parson of Prescotes, and Thomas de Ulnessby, parson of Fysshelak, of a messuage and bovate of land in Ketelwell and [a moiety of] the advowson of the church there, in aid of their maintenance.

Aug. 11. Pardon to Robert Haynard of Darfeld for aiding and abetting the Witney. death of Edward Bosevill, killed at Middelwode at the feast of Corpus Christi, 5 Richard II. By signet letter.

Aug. 8. Grant to Walter Hakebourne of the first portion of the parish church of Osenev Abbey. of Byseleye, void by the resignation of the king's clerk Richard Medeforde, in the king's gift by reason of the minority of the son and heir of the earl of March. By signet letter.

July 26. Grant, for life, to Elizabeth, prioress of St. Magdalene's by Bristol, of a tun of red wine of Gascony yearly at Christmas in the said town from the chief butler. By signet letter.
